The Birth of Jesus Christ was a great prophetic event, “Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.” (Matt. 1:23.) It is the fulfillment of Isaiah 7:14, “Therefore the Lord Himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, shall call his name Immanuel”.

As it was during the time of Christ’s birth, so is it also today. **“...seeing they see not...hearing they hear not.”** Nations reject God’s Word today as they did then. People may even quote the scriptures, but it does not do any good, if the words do not become alive in their hearts.

Is Christ your life, a living reality in your life? If He is not, then His birth in Bethlehem is to you an insignificant event. Eternity in heaven or in hell depends on your answer to this question: IS HE IN YOUR LIFE? IS HE YOUR SAVIOR AND LORD?

Jesus said, **“Verily, verily I say unto you, except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.”** (John 3:7.) What this new birth is, is explained in Romans 10:9-11: **“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.”** When we confess Him, and believe in our heart, at that very moment, we are born again and added to the Body of Christ, making our eternal destiny secure. Even though our salvation is the gift of God, we cannot hide the evidence of our new birth, which is that we are **“created unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.”** (Eph. 2:8-10.) Our lives will shine as witness for Him.

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem, certain wise men from the East came to Jerusalem asking **“Where is He that is born King of the Jews?”** (Matt. 2:2.) This caused a great stir for they already had a king, King Herod, who was not about to give up his throne.

“When Herod the king had heard these things, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him.” (Matt. 2:3.) He gathered the chief priests and scribes together and demanded to know if this was a true prophecy and where this would take place. They told him, **“In Bethlehem of Judea: for thus it is written by the prophet, and thou Bethlehem, in the land of Judah: for out of thee shall come a Governor, that shall rule my people Israel.”** (Matt. 2:5-6.)

It is interesting that these chief priests and scribes knew what was written in Micah 5, but there is no report saying that they did anything about it - they did not go looking for Messiah-King as did the wise men from the East. It does not do any good to know the scriptures, unless we believe them, act on them, and apply them to our lives.

It is very much the same today. We must remember that the entire Bible is God's Word to us! But today we can hardly find churches or ministries that pay any attention to the Bible prophecies yet to be fulfilled.

When Israel became a nation, May 14, 1948, that should have made Bible-reading people take note, for the prophecies of the end times are connected to this event. During the 1900 years that Israel was scattered among all nations of the world, even Bible believing people had given up the hope that God will bring them back to their land. Many had started to spiritualize the prophetic word found throughout the Bible, reasoning that perhaps God did not mean that they will literally gather in their own land, but maybe their gathering will be only "in spirit". However, countless scriptures had promised that the Jews will ultimately return to their own land, and that when they return, they will speak pure Hebrew. It seemed impossible indeed. But our God is God, and it happened. The scriptures also said that their return will be opposed by the entire world. Our generation has seen this happen. We see Israel and Jerusalem portrayed negatively on our daily news. The world opposes Israel, the only democracy in the Middle East!! Amazing, is it not?

Let's look at a couple of scriptures that are very specific. Ezekiel wrote why God scattered the Jews among the nations. He also wrote that God will do what He has said He will do. ***"Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord God; I do not do this for your sakes, O house of Israel, but for mine holy name's sake, which ye have profaned among the heathen...For I will take you from among the heathen, and gather you out of all countries, and bring you into your own land."*** (Ezekiel 36:22-24 - please read from verse 17-24.) The Bible tells us that after they are back in their own land, the entire world will be against them. The world is indeed against Israel. (The only allied country to Israel is the USA, and even she has lately turned against her.) God has said, ***"Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about..."*** (Zechariah 12:2-3.)

We learn from history that nations were established by wars; they conquered territory, settled it, and after that it was not disputed by others. But with Israel, it is a different story. As all know, Israel is a very small country, surrounded by enormous Arab nations that again and again have attacked her. She has won the war each time - but the world is demanding that she gives the land she won back to her attackers. That has never been a case with any other nation. Even a huge country like Russia, that attacked tiny Finland in the 1940's, has been allowed to keep the land she, by force, took away from Finland, land crucially important to Finland.

Why is the Israel's case different than all other nations'? Because that land is God's land - and this war against Israel is a spiritual war, whether people know it or not. This again is a fulfillment of God's Word. In Joel (3:1-2) God addresses all nations and gives them a warning for what they are doing. ***"For behold, in those days, and in that time, when I shall bring again the captivity of Judah and Jerusalem, I will also gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them for my people and for my heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations, and parted My land."*** Notice: It is God's land! God GAVE this land to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, and it was God who established her borders. It is a dangerous thing to oppose God who gave this land to Israel. God will call all to judgment that have ***"parted My land."***

Prophecy is not a popular subject today, but it will all take place just as God has said it will. He will come again, and that maybe soon, very soon. ***"It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God."*** (Hebr. 10:31.)

We in this ministry are often accused of taking the Bible too literally! ***I don't think we can be too literal - only not literal enough!*** If we ignore Him and His Word that does not change, the eternal fact spoken of in John 3:36 remains, ***"He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life; and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him."*** He paid for my sins and your sins when He died on the cross of Calvary - "[He] ***was buried, and He rose again on the third day, according to the scriptures"***, and ascended to heaven. This same Jesus will return just as it is written. (1 Cor. 15:1-4; Acts

1:11.) When He comes, first for His own, this prophecy will be fulfilled, ***“For the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words.”*** (1 Thess. 4:16-18.)

We cannot be saved until we recognize that we are lost. Are you His? When He comes, is He coming for you? We cannot put off asking Him into our lives till a later time, ***“for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come...”*** When He comes, and is here, then it is too late!

If you do not know Him personally, talk to Him today. He will make Himself known to you.

“My husband is Mormon and we have been going back and forth on certain subjects. The big one seems to be that fact that he says the Bible has missing information which he refers to as the apostasy where the church was lost for 40 years and everyone was corrupt. He says the Book of Mormon picks up that time period. Could you please give me scripture or any information to support how that is untrue. Also we discuss the trinity a lot, so any information on that would be helpful as well...thanks, C-----“

My reply:

Mormons have been taught that the Bible is not complete, that there are books missing. They assume that because the Old Testament mentions some books that are not included. Of course there were many secular books written during the same time as the OT was written - (about 1500 years.) Just because awareness of some book (or books) was known to a prophet of the OT, it did not mean that it too needed to be included. He just mentioned his awareness of them. Just as if you wrote a book about your life, or any subject for that matter, and you mentioned a book or books you had read, no one would expect you to add that book as a part of your book, right? The New Testament says that what is included is for God's purposes that people would come to know that ***Jesus is Christ, God with us.*** (Matt. 1:23; John 1:1, 14; 8:24 etc.) John said that there are other things written that are not included in this book, the collection of 66 books, we call the Bible. (John 20:30-31.) We have all what is needed in the Bible for us to know who God is, and how we can be saved.

I will include a few scriptures you asked for. Please read them carefully and prayerfully.

Jesus is God Almighty, the Creator of all. (Rev. 1:8; John 1:1-3; Col. 1:16.) ***He became a man to die for us, and give to us, who believe the gospel, the gift of salvation.*** (John 1:1, 14; 3:16; 1 Cor. 15:1-4; Eph. 2:8-9.) - The Bible teaches clearly from beginning to end that the Father is God. It teaches that Jesus is God and that the Holy Spirit is God, but also as adamantly teaches that there is only One God. (Deut. 6:4; James 2:19.) 1 John 5:7 says: ***“For there are Three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word (Jesus) and the Holy Ghost: AND THESE THREE ARE ONE.”*** ***Jesus is God and He is the Word.*** (John 1:1, 14.)

There has not been total apostasy from true faith as Mormonism teaches there was. The Bible predicted (1 Tim. 4:1) that ***“some (not all) shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits”***, but there always has been God's faithful remnant who have not forsaken their faith, but have clung to the Word of God as their anchor of faith. Our faith needs to be in Jesus who is the Word (John 1:1) and in His finished work of salvation in our behalf.

It is Jesus alone that saves just as John 14:6 and Acts 4:12 say. Christian churches, based on the Bible alone, are for a *fellowship* – a companionship with like-believers, but no church saves, only Jesus and

our faith in Him saves. **Salvation is the Gift of God, not of works.** (Read Ephesians 2:8-9 and Gal. 2:16-21.) The entire letter to Galatians refutes all that Mormonism and many other "isms" teach while trying to put people under the law rather than the grace of God. Please write again, and let me know if this helped and if your husband is willing to study the Bible with you. - In Christ, Rauni

Following is a combination of recently received questions from several people:

1. *What is the origin of Satan?*
2. *Is Lucifer a son of God and a spirit brother of all mankind as well as a brother of Jesus, born to God and His wives in preexistence, as Mormonism teaches?*
3. *Is Lucifer the name of Satan as is taught by the LDS Church? Where did Joseph Smith get this name – from the Bible?*
4. *What does the name Lucifer mean? Are Satan's ambitions and desires prophesied in Isaiah 14:12-14?*
5. *Can you explain Ezekiel 28: 13-19? Is Satan the "anointing cherub" talked about in this?*

I had researched most of these questions while I was still LDS, but then mainly from LDS teachings and writings, but after leaving Mormonism, nearly three decades ago, I finally had sense to check what the Bible has to say about these questions. We need to know what the Word of God that was given to us "for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness" (2 Tim. 3:16) has to say about all things pertaining to our faith and salvation. The following is what I have been able to discover about these questions:

1. Question: What is the origin of Satan?

The Bible teaches that Satan is the adversary of God and of mankind. Satan made his first appearance in Genesis 3 that describes a serpent who tempted the first human couple. That serpent was none other than Satan himself as is declared in Rev. 12:9; 20:2. Satan is his most common name, but the devil is what he is and it means that he is a *slanderer, accuser* and *deceiver*. [The article "the" in all 35 places (*the devil*) in the New Testament (NKJV) indicates that the devil is his title rather than his name.] He is called by many other names as well: *Serpent of Old* (Rev. 12:9; 20:2), *Wicked One or Evil One* (Matt. 6:13; 13:19, 38; 1 John 2:13), *Enemy* (Matt. 13:25, 28, 39), *Murderer* (John 8:44), *Deceiver* (Rev. 20:10), *Beelzebub, the Ruler of Demons* (Matt. 9:34; 12:24), *Belial* (2 Cor. 6:15), *Ruler or Prince of This World* (John 12:31; 14:30; 16:11).

2. Question: Is Lucifer a son of God, and spirit brother of all mankind and angels as well as a brother of Jesus, born to God and His wives in the preexistence as Mormonism teaches?

It is true that Mormonism teaches that all mankind and angels are spirit children born to God and his wives on another planet, in the state they call the *preexistence*, and then are sent to this earth to receive their physical bodies through human parents, and to be tested. If they pass the testing, they too, after their resurrection, can progress into godhood. **However, this is not biblical teaching! Men will not become gods!! Mankind did not preexist. God alone preexisted. Angels are not born to God,** but like the first man, Adam, they were **created by God**. There is a big difference in "born" and "created". "**Like begets like**". To beget is *begetting* something like you are. When you make or

create something, you make something different from yourself. What God begets is God; just like what humans begets is human. **That is why “the Only Begotten Son of God” is God – He was begotten by the Holy Spirit – and the Holy Spirit is God.** Men and angels are created by God, but not born to God. There are no mother-gods in heaven. Satan is a created angel. Furthermore, angels are not the same species as mankind. Angels are a direct creation of God, created to serve the Triune God. Adam was a direct creation of God too, but he, unlike angels, was made, created into the image of God, after His character. (Gen. 1:26-27.) Men are descendants of fallen Adam and thus not children of God, but “*children of the flesh*”, born as sinful creatures. (Romans 9:8; Ps. 51:5; Romans 5:12.) To become sons of God, we must be born again. (John 1:12; 3:6-7.) Jesus is not a spirit brother of mankind, nor angels. He is our God, the Creator of all – “For by Him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him, and for Him.” (Col. 1:16.)

3. Question: Is Lucifer the name of Satan as is taught in the LDS Church? Where did that teaching originate? Where did Joseph Smith get this name – from the Bible?

Yes, Mormonism teaches that Lucifer is Satan’s name. It is acknowledged as his name by Eve in LDS temple rituals, and in other doctrinal teachings of the Mormon Church. More than likely Joseph Smith learned about Satan’s name being Lucifer from Masonry. [Joseph Smith’s father and older brother, Hyrum, were Masons before Joseph became a Mason.] Only about six weeks after Joseph was initiated into Masonry, he presented Masonry’s ceremonies as his *revelation from God*, and Lucifer as the one who tempted Adam and Eve in the Garden. In the LDS temple ceremony, after Eve had taken a bite of the forbidden fruit, she acknowledges who her tempter was, and says, “... I know thee now. Thou art Lucifer, he who was cast out of Father’s presence for rebellion.” After which Adam asks Lucifer, “What is this apron you have on?” And he answers, “It is an emblem of my power and Priesthoods.” [Lucifer’s apron (as seen in the Salt Lake Temple), has Masonic emblems, among them the compass and square, etc. These are the same priesthood makings that are on the garments Mormons wear next to their skin... A question Mormons should ask themselves: Whose priesthood emblems are on our garments? Lucifer says they are his!) The Grand Commander of Scottish Rite Freemasonry, Albert Pike, in *Morals and Dogma*, p. 321, says, “LUCIFER, the Light-bearer!...Lucifer, the Son of the Morning! Is it he who bears the Light, and with its splendors intolerable blinds the feeble, sensual, or selfish Souls? Doubt it not!” Many New Age and pantheistic cults have likewise made Lucifer their “god”.

4. Question: What does the name Lucifer mean? Are Satan’s ambitions and desires prophesied in Isa. 14:12-14?

“Lucifer” is a Latin translation of a Hebrew name/word “*haylel*”, referring to “*bright morning star*”, also called “*shining one*”, and is rendered as “*day-star*” in some translations. [Note: We have adopted other foreign words to our vocabulary in addition to the Latin name “*Lucifer*”, when speaking of some other biblical concepts. As an example, we commonly use the Latin word rapture when referring to 1 Thess. 4:17 – instead of “*caught up*” or “*snatched up*” used in our English Bibles. We also use the Greek word, *Christ*, instead of *Messiah* from the Old Testament. Even the name “*Jesus*” is a Greek translation of the Hebrew name *Yeshua*.] The first one to translate the Old Testament scriptures into Latin was an early “Church Father”, Tertullian, 2nd Century convert to Christianity. He translated the Hebrew word “*haylel*” as *Lucifer*. He also interpreted Isa. 14:12-14 as

referring to the fall of Satan that Jesus also referred to in Luke 10:18. The name *Lucifer* carries the Hebrew meaning of a *bright (morning) star* quite exactly. Thus it was adopted as the name of Satan from 2nd Century on. St. Jerome, about 1200 years later, when he translated the entire Bible into Latin, used the same Tertullian's translation, *Lucifer*. (*Isa. 14:12*.) Many Old Testament prophecies carried a dual meaning – one to be seen and proven as a prophetic prediction almost immediately (thus proving that a prophet was speaking for God), and another meaning that was to be observed in the distant future. (The Prophet Isaiah is here (14:12-14) speaking in the present tense with sure assurance of the future fulfillment of his prediction.) **Many Bible scholars, as Dr. C.I. Scofield (Scofield Reference Bible), Dr. Charles Ryrie (New American Standard Study Bible), Dr. Gleason L. Archer (Encyclopedia of Bible Difficulties), Dr. Henry M. Morris (The Defender's Study Bible), King James Bible Commentary, William McDonald's Believer's Bible Commentary and Unger's Bible Commentary, just to mention a few, agree that Isaiah 14:12-14 has a dual meaning.**

Isa. 14:12-14 reads, "12. How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! 13. For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: 14. I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the Most High." Although there are two study Bibles, (that I know of), (NIV and NKJV) that limit the interpretation to the king of Babylon only, these above mentioned Bible scholars (and many more) emphasize that even though this prophecy is directed towards the earthly king of Babylon, it goes far beyond him! They point out that an earthly king could not have fallen from heaven (14:12), but a wicked spirit (Satan) is the one who had fallen as lighting from heaven, as Jesus pointed out in Luke 10:18, and was behind the corruption of this earthly Babylonian king. As in the Garden of Eden, where Satan possessed the serpent's body to tempt Eve, he does the same thing here with Babylon's king. (In 14:13) "*Stars of God*" are evidently angels (Job 38:7). Satan who had had a throne as God's "*anointed cherub*" (Ezekiel 28:14), here (v.13) wants to *exalt his throne* and reign over all the "*stars of God*" (holy angels) – all whom have been created to serve God and become ministers to those who would be "*heirs of salvation*" (Hebr. 1:14). Not only that, but he wanted to be like the *most High God*. Demonically inspired men, as in this case of the king of Babylon, become filled with self-pride, and just as Satan himself, want to govern the universe.

5. **Question: Can you explain Ezekiel 28:13-19? Is Satan the "anointed cherub" talked about in this scripture?** To give a qualified answer to this, I'd like to quote **Dr. Henry M. Morris**, who wrote: (The Defender's Study Bible, p. 878), "v. 13. *No one was in the Garden of Eden, except Adam, Eve and Satan. We are forced to conclude that this 'king of Tyrus' is none other than Satan, personally possessing and controlling the willing body of the proud 'prince of Tyrus'. Just as he possessed the body of the 'king of Babylon' (Isa. 14:12-15) and the body of Judas (Luke 22:3), he was able to possess and control the Tyrian monarch. His strategy is first personally taking control of an earlier king of Babylon and then the prince of Tyre, rather than leaving them to lower power in the demonic hierarchy...The mighty being addressed here (28:13) was clearly of the angelic order, for he had been 'created', not born. This statement could not have been true of an earthly king of Tyre. (v. 14) 'anointed cherub' on God's 'holy mountain'... [He] was evidently the highest of the cherubim, and therefore, the highest of all God's created angels. (v. 15) 'perfect in thy ways'. This being was of*

*incomparable beauty and wisdom (28:27), 'perfect in all his ways', causing his heart to be lifted up to attempt to displace His own Creator (Isa. 14:12-15). Ez. 28:15, 'till iniquity' was found in this perfect being – evidently the sin of rebellion against God – he who had been Lucifer ('Light-Bearer') became Satan ('The Adversary') and has remained God's greatest foe ever since. (28:27) 'corrupted in wisdom' – Satan's incomparable wisdom became corrupt when he deceived himself into thinking he could become God. He has tempted men and women ever since, persuading them (as he did Eve) that they also could be 'as gods' (Gen. 3:5) [what Mormonism also teaches!!!], but he had deceived himself most of all. His corrupted wisdom somehow persuaded him that he and God were the same type of being [the same as Mormonism also teaches]... (v. 17) 'to the ground'...God cast him to the ground – that is 'to the earth' – where He allowed him to test Adam and Eve...to see whether they also would rebel against God's Word, and seek to be gods themselves." **All above listed Bible scholars and Commentaries agree with Dr. Morris - not only in Isa. 14:12-14, but in Ezekiel 28:13-19 as well. Their scholarly statements are almost identical to Dr. Henry Morris' statements I quoted above.***



We'd like to thank you all for your prayers and support. The Lord called us into this work 26 years ago, and because He called, He has provided for our needs. It is interesting to note that with His call our "needs" became less and our "wants" disappeared. His calling and His provision during these 26 years is our guarantee for the future as well. One faithful brother bought several Study Bibles for us to give away!! **This is how our God makes impossible things possible!** That is all that we ask of the Lord – and even though times have been hard, our *needs* have been met. Times when we had thought that it is not possible, one of you had surprised us with a gift, and we were again able to help and do more than we thought we could. We rest on His Word that says, ***"And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, He heareth us: And if we know that He hears us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him."*** (1 John 5:14-15.)

Please pray for Dennis' health and strength, for his *heavy-duty work* takes a toll on him, but we are sure that the Lord is with him as he works long hours, and even after that helps me with answering letters and preparing for class materials, etc. – We just finished a week ago our 11-week course on Mormonism at Calvary Chapel. This time we had the smallest class we have ever had, but all who faithfully attended were a blessing to us, and we believe, also to each other. We are going to have a *course completion get-together party* at our home for them as soon as we can schedule it.

We are asking prayer for healing for Dale, Heber, Dwayne, Max, Dick, Grace, Stephanie, and peace in the heart for Beverly and assurance of the Lord's care He has promised when we put others ahead of our own problems and desires. - We are asking you to pray for many LDS people we have been working with during the last several months – they fear consequences with their jobs or families if they'd leave the LDS Church. Some are fearful to even let their Mormon families or friends know that they are studying the Bible and testing Mormon doctrines against the Bible. You can imagine how tormented they are! We pray that they would simply stop fearing and trust the Lord. That is the “secret” formula. We know that for us too it was the “turning point”. The Lord did put us through hardships for the sake of others and thus we can agree and say with Paul, ***“Grace be to you and peace from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort; who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God. For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, so our consolation also abounds through Christ. And now if we are afflicted, it is for your consolation and salvation, which is effective for enduring of the same sufferings which we also suffer...And our hope for you is steadfast, because we know that as you are partakers of the sufferings, so also you will partake of consolation. For we do not want you to be ignorant of our trouble...that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God...who delivered us...You also helping together in prayer for us, that thanks may be given by many persons on our behalf for the gift granted to us through many...For all promises of God in Him are yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.”*** (2 Cor. 1:2-11, 20; Ps. 119:49-50, 71.)

May the Lord bless you and give you peace during this season when we especially focus on God's gift of His Son, Jesus Christ. (John 3:16.)

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Thought for the month:

One major problem with religions like Mormonism that claim to have all the answers is: they do not allow questions.

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
