## H.I.S. Ministries September 2012 Newsletter, covering August 2012

Months do go faster as we age. It seems that we just started summer, and now we are into fall already!

This has been a very hot and dry summer here in Utah and in most of the Western States.

We traveled to Bend, Oregon for **the Berean Call's Annual Conference** going through Idaho and it was hot everywhere we went. We did not have, during those two weeks of traveling over 2000 miles, even one rainy day, but smoke-filled air due to fires in Idaho and in Oregon. We thank you for praying for our safety during our travels – we had no problems at all. We praise the Lord for all that.

We were sad that because of health issues, **Dave Hunt, the Founder of the Berean Call Ministry** and respected Author and Biblical Scholar, who has been also our mentor and teacher over two decades, **was not able to attend this conference**. We had very much hoped to see Dave and his wife Ruth there. We are praying for them and asking your prayers for them also.

**T.A. McMahan**, now the **President and Executive Director of the Berean Call Ministry**, had done a marvelous job in organizing this very well attended conference. His messages during the 2-full days of conference to hundreds of attendees from across the country and even from overseas, were from the heart and inspirational. Other speakers likewise delivered informative and very uplifting messages. They were: **Dr. Jobe Martin**, who spoke on **Biblical Creation vs. Evolution** and showed video clips from his DVDs as **“Incredible Creatures that Defy Evolution”**; **Dr. Renald Showers**, an author and Bible teacher for **The Friends of Israel Gospel Ministry**, delivered three great messages on **What On Earth Is God Doing** and on **the Second Coming of Christ**; **David James**, Executive Director of the Alliance for Biblical Integrity (ABI) spoke on **discernment and our needed determination to follow biblical doctrine**; **Mark Cahill**, well known youth conference speaker, **captivated all with his very intense and inspirational presentations on witnessing to the lost** and he equipped everyone on how to share our faith in Jesus Christ without fear; **Paul Wilkinson**, the **Assistant Pastor of Full Gospel Church in Cheshire, England**, spoke on the **history of the church** and how developments as *replacement theology* have adversely influenced Christians regarding restoration of Israel and Christ's imminent return.

We were able to purchase DVDs, CDs, books and other materials that each of the speakers had brought for the conference. During our travel home, as Dennis was driving, I read out loud Dr. Shower's small books, *The Coming Apocalypse*, *Behold, the Bridegroom comes!* and *What On Earth Is God Doing?* They were great.

During our travels we had good discussions on what we had learned and how we can use this information in our ministry to bring people into greater realization of what *God is indeed doing* and how urgent it is that we share Christ Jesus of the Bible with the Mormons, *“religious but lost people”*, and bring them into a saving relationship with true Jesus. Time is short.

We also talked about how Liberal Christianity, over the last 100 years or so, has, little by little, taken the focus from the **Gospel of Christ** that alone can save to *“the Social Gospel”* that is concerned about *“salvation of society”* rather than **eternal salvation of individuals**. Focus has been taken from what the Bible teaches about God, Jesus and salvation, and the *coming kingdom of God*, and emphasis is turned to *“kingdom now”* and how to eliminate poverty and how the church can *save the world* and eliminate its problems rather than be *saved out of it*. This earthly life is

very temporary – and it can end for any of us at any time, but eternity is endless and that means that we must put sharing the gospel and the **Eternal Kingdom of God first** and all other issues as secondary (Matt. 6:31-34). Feeding and helping the poor can open the door for sharing the gospel with them, but **without sharing the gospel, we have failed to be faithful to the One who came to save them out of the world.**

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We continue to receive questions about Mitt Romney and if, in our opinion, they should vote for him. We can only say that **we will not vote for him**, not because we think he is a bad person, quite the opposite, **but we cannot endorse him because he is a Mormon who has sworn oaths in a Mormon Temple promising that he will put the Mormon Church's benefits above all else through all the days of his life.** For sure Romney-presidency would be used to promote Mormonism, not only in United States, but around the world. That would mean perhaps millions more lost souls for eternity. Many are saying that they are willing to compromise and vote for Romney for *economical good of the country!* Will God approve His own to compromise? We don't think so! We are either for Him or against Him. **Mormonism believes in false gods, and "Jesus" who is a created being, brother of Lucifer and all mankind.** That is totally and eternally evil and absolutely against God of the Bible! If we follow the true Jesus, we also follow His doctrine and it is clearly taught in the Word of God. (2 Tim. 3:16.) ***How can we face our God once we have compromised our faith by promoting one evil, even if "lesser", over another?*** We, as former Mormons, knowing this organization from inside out, are speaking because we cannot be silent, but there are also many evangelicals who, even without personal experiences in Mormonism are warning about this as well. The following warning is from LivePrayer letter of 8/15/12: "THE LESSER OF TWO EVILS IS STILL...EVIL! 9 million evangelicals didn't vote in the last Presidential election, and more than that plan to stay home this November. [However this election time] gives Christians a chance to exercise their civic duty and vote for local, state, and national candidates who share their faith values, and send a loud message to this nation that the only answer for our land is to turn back to Jesus! For the Christian, this is not about politics, it is about souls!!! Our problems are NOT political, they are SPIRITUAL! In the end, God will decide who leads this nation for the next 4 years. Nobody has to play Satan's game of choosing between a man who has proven to be a true enemy of God and a 5th generation high priest of a satanic cult that propagates a false gospel leading souls to hell! The tortured logic that if you don't vote for a satanic cult member you are voting for Pres. Obama is laughable. You don't simply replace one evil person with another!"

Choosing a "lesser evil" can never be according to the will of God! Evil is evil – major or minor. We are told by many that if we do not vote for Romney, it would mean a vote for Obama. We do not think so! We must seek the will of God and vote according to our knowledge of Him. Our conscience should direct our actions in this matter as in other questionable issues that are occasionally set before us.

Here in Utah a Republican nominee will be chosen regardless of individual votes, so we can relax and *slide in the responsibility.* ☺ Our individual votes do not count in presidential elections, for it is *the electoral college* that elects the president. However, we must pray and seek God's counsel in all matters of life as Paul counseled Timothy (1 Tim. 2:1-5): ***"I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men, for kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior; who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus."*** We are again reminded of God's promises He gave to Israel in 2 Chron. 7:14, ***"IF My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."***

God has promised to hear us from heaven **if** we, who believe in Him and **"are called by His name"**, repent and pray. This country seems to be going down a pathway of sin and rebellion, and even many calling themselves believers in Jesus are supporting abortions and homosexuality especially forbidden by the God of the Bible. (Lev. 18:22; Romans 1:18-32) How can we even ask God's blessings, if we are not willing to turn from **"our wicked ways"?**

There might not be a lot of hope for the nations of this world that have turned against God and His salvation, but we who know Him, know that we have a hope of eternal life with Him, who is coming soon and to rule as the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords and sit on David's Throne as was promised to Mary in Luke 1: 32-33. David's Throne is an earthly Throne that He did not take in His First Coming, but He will do it when He comes again. (Zech. 14:9.)

Everyone of us who knows Jesus and has a personal relationship with Him, has a mission to proclaim His saving gospel, which is the *good news* that He died for us, was buried and resurrected after the third day, and that He freely gives eternal salvation to all who come to Him. It is that gospel that saves. (1 Cor. 15:1-4; Rom.10:9-10; Eph. 2:8-9.)

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**From our mailbox:**

This is my promised continuation of email-discussions I have had with a Mormon lady since May. (In last month's newsletter I answered her points 1 through 3.) Her points are in *italics*, my answers in regular text. We hope that from this discussion you can see how very difficult it is for a Mormon to abandon a lifetime of false teachings and rely on God and His word alone. It seems that she has given up under pressure. She has not responded after this. Please pray with us for this lady.

Continuing from last month -

**She wrote:**

4. *"Only four prophets in Bible were tested and focus was on Birth of Christ. Aren't these easy ones? What about the rest of the prophets like Moses? Where is proof of him splitting Red Sea and Noah and his arch? If we can't be shown where Red Sea was split then Moses must be false prophet?"*

**My reply:**

4. (Read Luke 24: 25-27.) ***"And beginning at Moses and ALL the prophets, He expounded unto them in ALL the scriptures the things concerning Himself."*** As you can see, Jesus said that **ALL prophets wrote about Him, including Moses!** Jesus commanded a study of **all the scriptures**, saying that ***"they are they which testify of Me"***. (John 5:39) - We have been for decades subscribers of *"Biblical Archeology Review"*. Every month we read reports of findings especially in Israel and in the Middle East. There are two videos we have viewed of findings on the bottom of Red Sea picturing Egyptian chariot-wheels that match the kind Egyptians used during that time. (Exodus 14.) If you want to get these videos they can be ordered from the *Friends of Israel Ministry*. I just saw a video-report, a week or two ago, on the Internet about another film-crew that has also taken pictures of Egyptian chariot wheels on the bottom of the Red Sea. I will try to find it and send it to you for you to see if you'd like. All prophets of God in the Bible were true prophets. There was a death penalty in Israel for false prophets! (Deut.18:20-22.)

**She continued:**

5. *"It took many, many years to find what the archaeologists have from the Bible. Couldn't it just take a long time to find the Book of Mormon proof? It hasn't really been given enough time to find out where the land Joseph Smith was talking about is before they came to a conclusion that its not true. Really the only main proof for the Bible is the tomb, scrolls, and temple."*

**My reply:**

5. Throughout history the locations of towns and cities of Israel and Middle East have been known and can be visited. It is not just the Bible that has that recorded. World History has reported of them since ancient times. Even all 29 kings of Israel mentioned in the Old Testament have been found recorded in secular writings. The ancient city, **Ur of Chaldea** (in modern day Iraq), **where Abraham lived 4000 years ago** (Gen. 11:28) **has been located**, as have Sodom and Gomorrah, reported as destroyed in Gen. 19:28-29. Babylon is likewise known and we can read reports from there even now, and throughout history. It is in the same vicinity where Tower of Babel was, built by Nimrod about 2000 years before Christ. (See Gen. 11.) We know where Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Nazareth, Damascus etc. are and they can be visited today. We do not need archeology to locate them – they still exist and are even in the daily news. Every single type of coin mentioned in the Bible has been found - and in abundance – but not one city or place named in the BoM or any coins mentioned in the BoM (see Alma 11:1-20) have ever been found. **People take tours to Israel and Middle East to visit places in the 'Bible land'.** **At the end of our Bible we have maps – covering both Old and New Testament times – these places are known - throughout history. But there are no maps in the Book of Mormon – for it is fiction – cities and places talked about there never existed!**

**She continued:**

6. *"Nephi (in the Book of Mormon) prophesied of Jerusalem falling and that was a true prophesy. How come that isn't counted?"*

**My reply:**

**6. Joseph Smith wrote the Book of Mormon in 1830! Of course he, as well the whole world, knew about Jerusalem being conquered by Babylonians in 586 B.C. It is recorded in the Bible.** Joseph Smith copied large portions to the BoM from the Bible! There was no such a person as Nephi - nor Lehi et al. American Indians (“Lamanites”) are not Hebrews from Jerusalem either! The Book of Mormon is fiction and its people are fictional characters made up by Joseph Smith’s vivid imagination talked about by his own mother in her book of Joseph Smith’s life – and also quoted by LDS GA and Historian, B.H. Roberts, in his work “Studies of the Book of Mormon”.

**She continued:**

7. *“If JS was a false prophet what has he done really to steer us away from Christ? There is good in the LDS church.”*

**My reply:**

7. “Christ” of Mormonism is not Christ of the Bible! Joseph Smith led his followers after *“another Jesus”*, warned about in 2 Cor. 11:4, 13-15 and in Matt. 24:24 etc. When Joseph Smith begun his religion, he started with an almost correct view of Jesus, **but he changed His Person** (about 14 years later) from *God who became a man* (John 1:1, 14; 8:23-24) to a brother of mankind and Lucifer, a created being. That is *“another Jesus”* – same name, but different person. – You are right, **there is “good” in many people of the Mormon Church**, but the **doctrine of the LDS Church is a deadly trap, leading to destruction** (as Isaiah warned in Isa. 8:20; 9:15b-16) which is eternal hell. Mormon people as people are “good”, humanly speaking (Matt. 19:17) but we can only become *righteous* in God’s eyes by *“putting on Jesus”* and *“His righteousness”*, **but that cannot happen until we become born again**. *“As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one.”* (Romans 3:10.) Read also Romans 10:1-4.

**She continued:**

8.” *Is it just the Mormon religion that you feel is at fault of worshiping the wrong Jesus or is it other religions too?”*

**My reply:**

8. **Not just Mormonism, there are many others.** For example *Jehovah’s Witnesses’ “Jesus”* is Michael the Archangel and not God who became a man. Muslims’ *“Jesus”*, called *“Isa”*, is a prophet of Allah and a *forerunner for Mohammed*. [Koran teaches that their god, Allah, does not have a son.] *Hare Krishnas* likewise talk about *“Jesus”* but he is not Jesus of the Bible either. *“Moonies”* (Rev. Moon) also have a different *“Jesus”* – and there are others. **The reason we focus on Mormonism is because it is our personal experience and knowledge.**

**She continued:**

9.” *Not really any other prophets got killed like Joseph Smith before he had a chance for all of his prophecies to come true. Couldn’t they have come true had he lived to prophesy more?”*

**My reply:**

9. If Joseph Smith had been a true prophet, his life-span would have had absolutely nothing to do if his “prophecies” were coming true. They did not! **The biblical standard of a true prophet is 100% accuracy – 100% of the time!** (Deut. 18:20-22.) Even one false prophecy makes a false prophet! There are some “good guessers” in the world, as “Jean Dixons” or fortune-tellers that can guess well at times and come up with something that may even happen, here and there, but **that is not what the prophet of God was! God does not make mistakes!** If man speaks for God – what he says has to be absolutely correct – 100% of the time!

**She continued:**

10. *“Are the [presenters] in videos (as DNA vs. the Book of Mormon, The Bible vs. the Book of Mormon) legit people and what could have been pro-Mormon was edited out of video? Seemed like the Mormon historians didn't get a fair chance to share their information.”*

**My reply:**

10. Absolutely they are “legit”. Watch them again. People on these videos are professionals who have done their research. Mormon historians have had plenty of “chances” to correct if there was anything to correct, but they cannot for it is impossible to prove a fictional BoM story. It is like trying to prove “Alice in Wonderland” or some other fairy-tail as true history!! It cannot be done! LDS Church has had plenty of their own “archeologists” admit that *the lack of evidence is too devastating for an honest person to continue trying to “prove” a fictional book*. One of them was Thomas S. Ferguson. See some of the statements we quoted in our booklet *The Truth About Mormonism*, p. 34 (starting from p. 30 to p. 36).

**She continued:**

11. "In the bible it says there is other words not yet revealed. Isn't it possible it could be what proves the book of Mormon as places revealed etc.?"

**My reply:**

11. The "rest of the story" (what was yet to be revealed) is found in the **Book of Revelation** that is "*the revelation of Jesus Christ*" (Rev. 1:1.) There is not anything more for God to reveal about our future for **His Word** takes us *from the beginning* (Creation – Genesis 1), past the *Great Tribulation* (Matt. 24; Rev. Chapters 6-19 - yet future), and *through the last judgment* – known as *the Great White Throne Judgment* (Rev. 20:11-15) and finally to *the New Heaven and New Earth, and Eternity with God*. (See Rev. Chapters 21 and 22.) **God has revealed it all to us** – the problem is that people are not studying His Word, but are just wanting more "books to collect dust".

**By ignoring His Word, the Bible, they insult God!**

**She continued:**

12. "Can discourses [scriptures] be changed over time?"

**My reply:**

12. **No one can change what God has said! He is an unchangeable God. He is the same Yesterday, Today and Forever.** (Hebr. 13:8.) The Lord warns us "*not to meddle with them that are given to change.*" (Prov. 24:21.) **Jesus**, whose title is *The Word of God*, said, "*Heaven and earth shall pass away, but My words shall not pass away.*" (Mark 13:31; Matt. 5:18; Isa. 40:8.) The original text of the Bible cannot be changed. Translated words, explaining the text, many vary, but even they must carry the same meaning as in the original Hebrew or Greek text.

**She continued by saying:**

*"I have many more questions as well. I had my husband watch the videos and I shared some information with him and my mother. My husband actually came up with some of the questions. He did have a good point on some so I told him I would ask you. My mom says she has been searching the B of M and doesn't see anything where JS had more than one wife so I shouldn't believe it."*

**To that I replied:**

The Book of Mormon is not about Joseph Smith, or about his life or his polygamy, even though it was written by him. **It is supposed to tell a story of ancient peoples** who came from Jerusalem and lived on the American **Continent**... however it does speak against polygamy... (Jacob 2:24, 27.) Joseph Smith started to practice polygamy in early 1830's but it was not until 1843 that Joseph Smith (in D&C 132) **COMMANDED polygamy** (132:4) and he even threatened Emma, Joseph Smith's only legal wife, with destruction if she was not agreeable to his many wives. (See D&C 132:54.) **Joseph Smith had** (according to LDS Church's own records), **at least 33 plural wives**. LDS professor, Todd Compton, wrote a history of the 33 plural wives of Joseph Smith. His book is titled '*In Sacred Loneliness*'. He reports that **11 of Joseph Smith's wives were married to other living husbands**. (What kind of man would do that? Only an adulterer and pervert – right?) In addition to these eleven married women, Joseph Smith had two 14-year old "wives" and several others who were still in their teens... Yet he lied about it all – saying that he only had one wife!! He lied because polygamy was illegal then as it has always been illegal in this country.

**She continued saying that her mother has** "*...said that all other information is by humans and not scripture. Both (my mother and husband) feel I 'shouldn't question (the church) because people have ulterior motives and wouldn't put this information out there if there wasn't something in it for them'. She says people just make up their own churches. Most of the time it is because they have a grudges or [want] money. Is your ministry a church?"*

**My reply:**

I have already replied to your challenge about this when you, in your first letter to me, accused us of doing this work for our gain... I said then and I say it again: **We do this work of informing because we care about Mormons, and I care about you. We do not want anyone ending up in eternal damnation because they did not know the truth!** What you do with this information is totally up to you – there is nothing for me personally in it – you know that. (I have sent to you DVDs, Books etc. – all free of charge, have I not?) The Old Testament prophet, Hosea, lamented, "**My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.**" (Hos. 4:6.) I wish someone would have given me this information early on in my Mormon-life!!

**Our ministry is not a church.** We are just a "information ministry". My husband works full time in remodeling and wood-working to earn our modest living. I gave up my profession to do the ministry work full time. We attend a non-denominational Christian church, called *Calvary Chapel* in Salt Lake City.

However, I am sure you know that the Mormon Church does their “work” for money! How else would they be a *Multi-Billion Dollar Corporation!* They are perhaps the richest church in America. They are making over 20 million dollars EVERY DAY, and over 10 billion annually.

She still continued, saying:

*“I don't want to come across accusing. I really feel you have answered many questions that most won't. I am one that needs answers and maybe others don't. I also need to know that it all makes sense. For me the church tells me where I have been, why I'm here and where I am going. That is why I asked what your belief about that was.”*

I replied:

**You are perhaps thinking, as Mormons have been taught, that we all came from heaven. Not true.** There is no preexistence of mankind. We did not come from heaven. See what Jesus said about that in John 8:23-24, 3:13, 31. **Jesus, who is God, He alone came from heaven, we did not.** Answers to all these questions are in the Bible. Start with the Gospel of John that was written to the world at large and you will be amazed of the **simplicity that is in Christ, the Word of God.** (See: 2 Cor. 11:2-4.).

She is worried and said:

*“My mom is scared I am risking my whole family's salvation. I am scared of that also.”*

My reply:

I can affirm that **you will not risk anything by studying the Word of God, the Bible** that even Mormons claim to believe. **Truth will set you free from all that is false.** (John 8:31-32, 36; 17:17.) **Truth will not change.** There is no salvation in following false gods, and “*another Jesus*”. **Jesus said that He alone is the Way, the Truth and He alone gives eternal Life.** (John 14:6.) Not Joseph Smith's church, or any church for the matter, can save. (Gal. 2:21.) Please read entirely Paul's letter to Galatians. It is only 6 short chapters, and you will see that law and works do not save anyone. **Salvation is the Gift of God.** (Eph. 2:8-9) One cannot work for a gift. If you do it would no longer be a gift! Jesus was asked what is the “*work of God*”. He answered: “***This is the Work of God that you believe on Him whom He (God) hath sent.***” (John 6:28-29.)

She continued:

*“...Part of me says no matter how much proof there is [against Mormonism], I have to **hold on**. I don't want to be wrong in the end. I don't want to study my way out of the church, as they say.”*

My reply:

What are you saying!? *Hold on* to false gods and false Jesus!? How can you reason with that? Besides, if Mormonism is true, you could not study yourself out of it! **Truth never changes!** **But if you do not study, but follow false gods, you are wrong now, and will be wrong also in the end!!!**

She continued her wonderings, saying:

*“So many people that leave the church seem to do so because they can't deal with all the work and expectations that come with it.”*

My reply:

**Works and obedience to the law cannot save anyone.** (Gal. 2:16-21; Rom. 4:2-8.) We are saved by God's grace through faith in Jesus (Ephesians 2:8-10) After we are saved, we want to serve God because He first loved us and has work for us to do now that we are His own. We do not do works to be saved by them – we do good works BECAUSE WE ARE SAVED! (1 John 5:13.) We insult Jesus if we think that what He did for us was not enough!

She could not believe that our faith in Jesus alone can save... She said:

*“It's hard and seems like if all we have to do is believe **that is too easy.**”*

My reply:

Can you not see that your statement is incredible? **Our salvation cost God His Son.** “*Wages of sin is death*” (Rom. 6:23). He paid it all. It was not easy. We love Him, we follow Him and work for Him because He saved us and He first love us.

In her closing statement to me nearly a month and a half ago she wrote:

*“Anyway, I don't really know what I will do from here. I do know things are changed forever now that I know what I know... I also know that I wanted the church to be true. I have my husband and family telling me that it is true but yet there are the facts...”*

I replied, pleading with her to study the Bible, pray and trust in Jesus, who is God Almighty (Rev. 1:8) and that only through repentance and belief in Him we can have our sins forgiven and go to heaven. (Luke 13:5; John 8:24.) ( I have not heard from her for over a month – but we pray that she will still study the Bible and find courage to accept the Truth and be saved.) God is good, and He loves this Mormon lady. Maybe if we all pray for her from our heart, she will be able to stand on Truth and “come away from them”.

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We have so many reasons to praise God for those who have found truth and gained courage to stand for Jesus. We have mentioned Becky and Sam in our past letters, for they are such an encouragement and inspiration to us. Becky has been letting us know about those to whom she and her husband have been able to witness and bring out of Mormonism. Even though they themselves are only about 6 month old as born again believers in Christ and yet through their witness Becky’s Mormon father has accepted the Lord, as has her sister, Mary, and just last week her brother and his wife (parents of seven small children), have come to know and accept the truth. Becky and Sam were just last Sunday meeting with a couple, their good LDS friends, to let them know why they left Mormonism. Becky called asking for prayer that they will represent the Lord and His love to these friends well. **Having this urgent desire to witness was made possible for them because from the very day we started talking and sharing information with Becky and Sam, they believed and took it to their heart that the answers to all these questions, and source for strength is found in the Word of God.** We gave them Bible-study CDs starting with *The Gospel of John*, then *The Book of Daniel*, after that *Revelation*, then *Joshua* and *Ezekiel*. This is a lot in 6 months! We have just recently given to them also *The Gospel of Matthew*, *The Gospel of Mark*, *Colossians*, *Philippians* and *Hebrews* – they are in a process of studying them, and we will give them more later... Becky and Sam have asked (and received) several copies of the John Study CDs that they can give immediately to Mormons they witness to. They are doing that for it was the Gospel of John that literally “fired them up” soon after they started studying it. When our hearts are open to the Lord, God responds and the Holy Spirit will fill our hearts and *teaches us all things*. (John 16:13-15; 14:26.) God can work miracles through everyone who equips him/herself with His Word and loves the Lord enough to be in His Word daily.

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We have many prayer requests – some for health problems, some for other trials, some for courage to witness.
