Another year is beginning! Amazing! We had hoped to be with the Lord in His Kingdom by now, but we also thank Him that He has given us more time to tell others about His love and salvation that He is offering to all who would just accept His Gift. *"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life."* (John 3:16; Eph. 2:8-9.) He died to pay in full our sin-debt and free us from the penalty of our sin. (Romans 6:23; Lev. 17:11.) He is inviting everyone to come to Him and have eternal life with God. All we need to do is to believe in Jesus, and that He is God, for only God can forgive sins. (John 6:29; 8:24; Mark 2:7.) When we confess Him and believe with our whole heart (Rom. 10:9-10) we are, in that instant, born again and have BECOME God's children. (John 1:12-13.) Life on earth is short. Eternity is forever, and what we do during this short earthly life affects our "forever". The only things we have in this life that last forever are God, His Word and souls of men. Our deepest desire is to communicate God's love and His clear message of salvation through His Son to all whom the Lord brings to our sphere of influence and thus secure their eternity with God. Many think that eternity is "way out yonder." But eternity is only a heartbeat or trumpet call away. Jesus is coming "in the twinkling of an eye." Suddenly, cataclysmically, just like that He comes. We must be ready and help others to be ready also. *"The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance."* (2 Peter 3:9 NKJV.) I am sure that we all have wondered why Jesus has not returned yet. Many even mock our beliefs of His coming, saying just what Peter predicted that they'd say, *"Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, and saying, where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation. For this they willingly are ignorant of..."* (2 Pet. 3:3-5.) For all of us *prophecy watchers*, time seems to be ripe for His judgment to fall on this wicked world, does it not? **The only reason I can think of why He has delayed His coming is because there is a certain number of those who will come to Him on this side of Rapture, a number that only the Lord knows.** Paul must have been referring to that in Romans 11:25, where he talks about why *Israel is blinded to the gospel* and will be, but not forever, only *"until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in"*. You may ask: *Come in where? To the Lord Jesus and His gospel and be saved!* The Lord is waiting on these Gentiles whom He also foreknew to come to salvation before the Rapture. He may be waiting on our family member, your family member, a neighbor or a co-worker, but one of these days, perhaps very soon, **Jesus will come. He has promised that. It is the mercy and love of God that holds back the Rapture and the Second Coming of Jesus, but one day He will come.**

It is very sad that many if not most of the Christian churches have taken a stand against Israel and are saying that *because Israel as a nation rejected Jesus 2000 years ago, God turned against them and has given the promises He had*

given to Israel to the Church. They say that the Church has replaced Israel. This cannot be true, for if God forsakes what He had promised to Israel throughout His Word, how can anyone believe that He will not forsake the Church as well if they become unfaithful? God has not forsaken Israel. God is God who keeps His promises. His promises are true. He will be faithful to His chosen people, and He will be faithful to each of us who believe in His Son, the Messiah of Israel for salvation and our future. It was with Israel that God made His covenants, not with Gentiles. God promised the land to Israel forever. (Gen. 15:18.) (See also Jer. 31:31-40.) Jesus said that *Salvation is of the Jews*. (John 4:22.) God had set apart the Jewish nation as His chosen earthly people. The Word of God was given to all nations and people through the Jews, and it was through Jews that Messiah was given. Paul wrote (Rom. 1:16), *“For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth: to the Jew first, and also to the Greek* (i.e. Gentiles)”. We need to thank God for the Jews for without the Jewish Scriptures, we would not know about God and His salvation offered to all. (John 3:16.) We need to keep our eyes on Israel, for it is through Israel that we can see God’s timing and how near the Lord’s Second Coming is, even though Israel, as a nation, is still in unbelief (Ez. 36:19-24), but a change is coming to their hearts. (Ez. 36:25-38; Rom. 11:25-26.) The prophetic signs for the Lord’s Second Coming to settle the affairs of men are everywhere. He is, by them, confirming that we are in the *“last days”*. Paul wrote to Timothy concerning that time, even our time, saying, *“But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having a form of godliness but denying its power.”* (2 Tim. 3:1-6 NKJV.) Is Paul not describing our time perfectly? The Lord’s Coming is getting closer and closer – and that means that the Rapture is seven years closer than His Second Coming when “every knee shall bow and every tongue confess to God”! (Rom. 14:11.)

God’s promises to Israel are clear and our faith in the Lord though His promises to Israel can only grow. God changed Abraham’s grandson Jacob’s name to ISRAEL (Gen. 32:28), a name which means *“he who persists and rules with God”*. Let’s look what the Word of God says about God’s covenants and promised future for descendants of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob/ISRAEL.

“The name ‘ISRAEL’ is used 2566 times in the Bible – more than any other name or subject, next to the LORD Himself. ISRAEL refers to the unique nation which was promised to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. (Gen. 12:2; 35:11.) The word ISRAEL refers to the people who came out of bondage in Egypt and were given commandments of God. (Deut. 4:1, 7-8.) The twelve tribes who descended from the sons of Jacob are the Nation of ISRAEL. (Gen. 49:28.) [The ten Northern tribes, after the kingdom of Saul, David and Solomon, was divided in the days of Rehoboam.] These ten Northern tribes were called ISRAEL, and the Southern kingdom of two tribes [Judah and Benjamin] was called JUDAH. (1 Kings 12:16-21.) The land which was promised to Abraham (Gen. 13:14-15) and to his descendants, Isaac and Jacob, was called THE LAND OF ISRAEL. (Gen. 17:8; 26:3; 35:12; Ps. 105:8-11; Ez. 37:11-14.) The nation of people who will be living in the land when the Messiah returns, and who will come to believe on Him, is called ISRAEL. (Zech. 12:10; Rom. 11:25-27.) The word ‘Jews’ is used 257 times in the Bible, of which usages 175 are in the New Testament. The term ‘Jews’ is also used in the gospel of John to refer to the Israel’s religious leaders. (John 5:10, 16, 18; 7:13; 19:6-7.) Those Jews who became believers in the Messiah are called ‘Israel of God’. (Gal. 6:16.) God refers to Himself as ‘the LORD God of Israel’ 108 times, and as ‘God of Israel’ 203 times. The New Testament separates people into three categories: Jews, Gentiles and the Church of God. (1 Cor. 10:32.) The church of Jesus Christ, the Church of God, is composed of both Jews and Gentiles who have believed in Him. (1 Cor. 12:13; Gal. 3:28; Eph. 2:11-18; 3:6.) The nation ISRAEL will never cease to exist – and the land will be theirs forever. (Jer. 31:35-37.) God says that! ISRAEL has never been forsaken by God. (Rom. 11:1-2; Ps. 89:29-37; Lam. 3:31-32.) During the coming Tribulation, 144,000 from the tribes of ISRAEL will be protected by God and used by Him to spread the gospel to the whole world. (Rev. 7:1-8; 14:1-6.) During the Tribulation, ISRAEL will be protected and nourished by the Lord. (Rev. 12:14-17.) The Church has NEVER replaced ISRAEL in God’s prophetic program. [The OT had foretold that Gentiles’ relationship with God will provoke Israel into jealousy, thus the church could not be Israel. (Rom. 10:19.)] The word ISRAEL itself is prophetic, separate and unique. That name is the means by which God reveals His character and His attributes of love and faithfulness to the entire world. “For you (Israel) are a holy people to the LORD your God; the LORD your God has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples on the face of the earth. The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples, but because the LORD loves you, and because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers, the LORD has brought you out with a mighty hand,

and redeemed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. Therefore know that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments.” (Deut. 7:6-9, NKJV.) **There always has been a remnant of God’s people ISRAEL who have not forsaken Him. (Isa. 10:22; 11:11, 16.) Jesus (in Hebrew – Yeshua) told the Samaritan woman that “salvation is of the Jews” (John 4:22; see also Rom. 1:16.) All true believers in the LORD God are ‘children of Abraham’ by faith in the Messiah of ISRAEL. (Rom. 4:11-12; Gal. 3:7.) “Verily Thou art a God that hidest Thyself, O God of ISRAEL, the Savior.” (Isa. 45:15.) “But ISRAEL shall be saved in the LORD with an everlasting salvation.” (Isa. 45:17.)** Messiah of ISRAEL, and the whole world, was born a Jew, and He is our coming King who will rule and reign from Jerusalem, in ISRAEL. (Luke 1:32-33.) **ISRAEL is not Palestine, which was a name borrowed by Romans from Israel’s enemy, Philistia (Joel 3:4.) The Romans gave the name Palestine to the land of Israel in A.D. 135 to mock and belittle Israel after a Roman general had destroyed the temple and Jerusalem (70 A.D.) and killed over 1.5 million Jews. God will judge the nations that seek to take and/or divide HIS land. (See Joel 3:2.) Regardless of the efforts of the haters of ISRAEL surrounding her, God will protect His land and His people. We are commanded to “pray for the peace of Jerusalem.” (Ps. 122:6.)**

ISRAEL has to be there for the Lord Jesus to come back. We see that anti-Semitism is demonic for it originated with Satan who has hated Israel from the start. He has tried to destroy God’s plan for redemption of souls of men. The study of the Bible, both OT and the NT, will show that. When he convinced people to kill Jesus, he thought he won, but he did not know then that the Lord will come again. (See 1 Cor. 2:7-8.)

When Satan discovered that there will be the Second Coming, he focused his hatred against all Jews, for when the Lord comes again, He, according to the Scriptures, will come to Jerusalem as the King of kings and the Lord of lords. Satan is working hard to make sure there is no Israel and that no Jews are left for God to accomplish His plan. Hitler was planning on getting all Jews killed, but at the end he himself got killed. After Israel, in 1948, became a nation again, Satan has concentrated his efforts to destroy Israel and all the Jews specifically through Muslims. Satan can win only if he can get the Jewish nation destroyed. If that could happen, God would lose and Jesus could not come back as prophesied. That is how Satan plans to win. We all, as believers in God and His Word, must unite in prayer for Israel’s protection. We know that God watches over ISRAEL, but He expects His own to demonstrate our love for Him through prayer while waiting for His appearance. (Rev. 22:20.) We praise God that faith in Jesus as Messiah of ISRAEL is now growing in ISRAEL.

Question from a wondering young LDS: *“The Mormon Church teaches that we all lived with our heavenly father and mother(s) on another planet before becoming to this earth as mortal beings. Since there had to have been many tens of billions of spirits born to God, we believe that God had to have many wives, as our earlier leaders like Orson Pratt openly taught. That got to be a reason why Joseph Smith brought revelation of eternal marriage and polygamy (D&C 132), so that when we are exalted and become gods and goddesses, and if we have many wives, we too can increase our family of spirit children faster and can send them to an earth we will organize for them. We know from these teachings that what our heavenly father and mothers are doing, we will do also. It is good to know that we all are God’s children and that we lived with him. I just wonder if we had fights with our brothers and sisters there as we have here? We know that Jesus was our elder brother there and that Lucifer and Jesus fought which one of them would become the savior of the rest of us – so there must have been other fights also for other positions to be filled when we come to this earth. I have learned that most of the important positions were already spoken for there, as who would be a prophet, or a leader in the church. We have learned that Joseph Smith was chosen there as was Jeremiah and others. I wonder what Protestants and Catholics think when they are not taught anything about our past lives? I have learned that you and your husband left the Mormon Church. Why? You must feel very lost when you have no teaching now about where you are going to go and what you are going to be doing after you die. Some Christians have told me that they will just sing and praise the Lord forever and ever. That does not sound to me as something to look forward to. I get bored now if I have to sing even an hour at church meetings.”*

Reply: **God’s Word, the Bible is Truth. (John 17:17.) From the Bible we learn that we did not come from heaven. Only Jesus came from heaven, for He is God. (See: John 1:1, 14; 3:13, 31; 8:23-24.) We were not born to God in preexistence as spirit children. We were created in a womb of our mothers. (Isa. 44:2, 24.) God creates a spirit of man “within him”. (See Zach.12:1.) Jesus and Lucifer are not brothers! Lucifer is a fallen angel. Jesus is God who created all things,**

including angels. (John 1:1-3; Col. 1:16). Angels are a different species, created by God to serve Him. We were not born first as spirits as Mormonism teaches, but “natural” (physical) and after we come to know Jesus as our Savior, and receive Him, we are born spiritually. (See 1 Cor. 15: 46; John 1:12-13; 3:3, 7.) There is only one God. Men will not become gods. (See Isa. 43:10; 44:6, 8b.)

By the way, I am familiar with these LDS teachings about preexistence you are referring to. It is simply a fantasy created by Joseph Smith, and his followers added to it. During the recent decades the LDS Church has not openly talked about *god and his many wives*, but maybe you have read LDS apostle Orson Pratt’s book, ***The Seer?*** Pratt wrote a lot about this part of Mormon doctrine. That teaching is also un-biblical. God is not married, and we are not His children until we receive Jesus and BECOME His children. (John 1:12 – see also Romans 9:8.) **There is no marriage in heaven.** (Matt. 22:30.)

You may have read from an older LDS Priesthood manual, ***Gospel Through Ages***, about Lucifer’s and Jesus’ ***contention of becoming a “savior”***, or *fight*, as you called it. It is a teaching in the LDS Church, but it is not true either. Jesus is God who became a man to save us from condemnation we deserve. (John 3:16.) He loves you and calls you to come to Him and be saved.

I hope that you will start studying the Bible, book by book, and learn who God is, and that Jesus is God who came to save us all from our sins. (See 1 Cor. 15:1-4; Romans 10:9-10; Eph. 2:8-9.) The Bible teaches us clearly and firmly where we go after this life is over. All who belong to Jesus and are born again, will go to be with Him. The Bible tells us that heaven is beyond our ability to describe (1 Cor. 2:9), but just looking at the beauty and wonder of this fallen world we now live in, we can be sure that when **God creates a new heaven and a new earth** (Rev. 21:1), it will be a wondrous place. Before that new creation, after the Rapture, we will live with Jesus in ***His Millennial Kingdom***, and we will ***“reign with Him a thousand years.”*** (Rev. 20:6.) This sounds very adventurous to me - nothing *boring* about that. If you have further questions, please write again.

Another LDS “challenge” presented to us: *“You ought to know that Jesus is our elder brother and he atoned in the Garden of Gethsemane for Adam’s transgression that had brought death to all men. Jesus is the literal Son of God, for His father was an exalted man and God, not the Holy Ghost, as you Bible believers say. Because Jesus suffered and bled for all mankind in the Garden, all people will be redeemed from death and be resurrected. That is what salvation by grace without works means. But to be able meet God and go to Celestial kingdom and there progress into godhood, we have to work hard throughout our lives and earn it.*

Because not all people want to do what it takes to become exalted (god), God has prepared lesser kingdoms for them – Terrestrial and Testial kingdoms. All dead people who have not belonged to the LDS Church or who have not accepted the true gospel after their death in the Spirit Prison, will have to wait for a time when their works will be judged and determination is made where they will spend eternity. All worthy Mormons who have died are in the Paradise and from there they are working to preach the gospel to the dead who are in the Spirit Prison. After the judgment, the Spirit Prison (also called hell) will be come to an end.

Only those who had a perfect knowledge and a testimony of the true church and the true gospel of Joseph Smith, but who later rejected it and left the only true church and became apostates, they will be sent to outer darkness, and there to live with the Devil and his angels for eternity.

I am saying to you that it is best to stay in the only true church even if you are not sure about all LDS teachings, for at least that way you can go to one of the 3 heavens. Only apostates will go to outer darkness with the devil. I would suggest that you and everyone who has left the Mormon Church would consider returning and being re-baptized, just in case. Living with the Devil forever in outer darkness is not a good future for you.

I have read that Joseph Smith had said that even the Testial kingdom, lowest of the kingdoms where unbelievers and murderers, adulterers and thieves will go, is a wonderful place, much better than our old earth now is. Think about that!”

I will give you a brief answers here in case you are not able to access our website at this time:

Jesus is not *our elder brother*, but our Creator and God who became a man to pay for our sins. (John 1:1, 14; 3:16.)

Only God can forgive sins. (Mark 2:7.) In order to be forgiven and go to heaven, **we must believe that Jesus is God.** (John 8:23-24, 58.)

Jesus prayed in agony in the Garden of Gethsemane to ask the Father if there was **any other way** to bring salvation to mankind than going to the Cross, but **there was no other way than going to the Cross and dying for men. Jesus did not die in the Garden, and thus atonement did not take place there, but on the Cross of Calvary. He had to die for our sins for “wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”** (Rom. 6:23.) **By His death of the cross** (Phil. 2:8), **He, God, became our perfect blood sacrifice** as was taught throughout the Old Testament. (See: Lev. 17:11.)

Jesus was not begotten by *an exalted man-god*, nor by any man, **He was begotten by the Holy Spirit.** (Matt. 1:18-23.) **Jesus is the sinless Virgin-born Son of God.** (Sin nature is inherited from a seed of man – thus no man was involved in His conception.) **God is Spirit.** (John 4:24; Luke 24:39.) Salvation to God’s Kingdom is only by **God’s grace through faith.** **“For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.”** (Eph. 2:8-9 NKJV; Rom. 10:9-10.) Notice that Paul, writing to **believers in Ephesus**, says, that **“by grace you have been saved”** –i.e. **when you became a born again believer in Christ, salvation became your present possession, not something that you’d be working for to earn. Those who are saved know it now.** (1 John 5:13.) **Paul knew it, they knew it.** God **gives** salvation to those who confess that they are sinners and not worthy of it (1 Tim.1:15; Matt. 9:13), but they receive it only on the basis of the Person and work of the Lord Jesus Christ. **Grace is the gift that God gives to those who by faith receive Jesus.** (John 1:12.) **Thus Grace is free and unconditional gift. It cannot be earned.** Even trying to earn it disqualifies it as the Gift of God. We cannot add anything to our salvation – *not a membership in a church, not baptism, not keeping ten commandments, not giving money, not living good and moral life, etc.* In other words, **people are not saved by works of any kind.** They are **not saved by faith plus works!** (See Romans 11:6; 3:27.) **We have to put our trust in the Lord and His Word. To trust the Lord is the most logical and reasonable thing to do, for God cannot lie.**

You speak of three heavenly kingdoms and **of hell that will end**, and of **“an outer darkness”** where sinners, non-Mormons and the devil and his angels will go. **You do not find this teaching in the Bible**, nor even in the Book of Mormon. **They both teach of one heaven and of an everlasting hell. Interestingly the Book of Mormon teaches even more than the Bible about everlasting hell of “lake of fire and brimstone, which is endless torment.”** (See 2 Nephi 28:21-25.) The BoM teaches that when people say, *“Zion prospereth, all is well – and thus the devil cheateth their souls and leadeth them carefully down to hell. And behold, others he flattereth away, and telleth them there is no hell...till he grasps them with his awful chains, from whence there is no deliverance...Wo to him who that crieth: All is well!”* (I recall a song in the LDS Church with that chorus: ALL IS WELL, ALL IS WELL!) **Notice, that the BoM says that it is the devil who says that there is no hell, i.e. that it ends!**

God loves all mankind and He has Himself paid the penalty we deserve – all we have to do is believe on Him and be saved. (John 3:16; 6:29.) Please reconsider. Read the Bible, beginning with the Gospel of John and ask the Lord to save you. – I hope that we can talk more.

During this past year, we have been busier than ever. Perhaps that is why this year seemed to have passed so fast. This last day of the year we are counting our blessings. You, our friends and supporters, are our blessing that allows this work to go on. God has chosen you to be our source – and we thank Him of you. God has blessed us with reasonable health and we have been able to be at this work pretty much 24/7. When we are at home, Dennis works with his carpentry work 5-6 days a week, and he still has strength to help me with the ministry work too. *He is the stronger vessel, for sure.* He did extremely well during our long travels. Our trip to Finland was very trying for me both physically and emotionally. We were *“on the go”* every day, traveling over 2000 km by rental car, and being almost every day in a different city, and meeting with a lot of people. Nine- hour time difference between home and Finland, plus 22-23 hr. daylight there made it difficult to sleep. We were sure that this was our last trip to my home-country and that made it emotionally hard for me – and even for Dennis. He loves Finland too. We pray that there will be spiritual fruit maturing as a result of our trip. We are in touch with several persons there, and we pray for all of them. God is good and He reaches for those whom He already knows that will respond to His call before the *“curtain falls”*. It is hard to think and accept that some of them who heard the message of the gospel did not receive it into their hearts to be saved. **Our souls, made into the image of God, will exist forever – but where? Will they be in heaven or in hell?** We did our best and we know that God loves the lost more than we do, but He still allows them to choose freely – even if they do not choose Him. [Sigh]

We are currently in contact with several Mormons here locally who are, for family reasons, still actively involved in their Mormon wards, but we praise God that they willing to learn and that they are growing in the knowledge of God, and seeing that they have been lied to by the LDS Church. It is heart-breaking for many.

We will continue teaching our classes at our home for now. It is easier for us when it involves only a few people. Maybe later we will start again at Calvary Chapel. We have talked about that with our pastor, but have not set the date as of yet.

We are plenty busy with emails, phone-calls and visits from those who are seeking to know the truth about Mormonism. **Information that has become available on the Internet about history and practices of the Mormon Church has pushed the LDS Church into more honesty**, and they have now had to admit many things they have, up until these times, firmly denied, as **Joseph Smith's marriages to about 40 women, 11 of them being married women with living husbands, in addition to nine young teens, two of them only 14 years old.** Also finding out the fact that **Joseph Smith did not "translate the Book of Mormon from the gold plates", but that "he used a rock in his top-hat" as medium**, has also shaken many "testimonies". **The fact that General Authorities of the LDS Church are paid** has not been known by most Mormons, who have insisted that **they have no paid clergy** as other churches have. **Now they are shocked to find out that the LDS leaders are paid, and paid very well!**

We want to be available for these people as they discover the truth about Mormonism that could drive them to desperate actions unless they can talk to others who have gone through these things and found the Lord God of the Bible, salvation and true peace for their souls. **We are asking that you pray for Mormons now more than ever** for many of them can become suicidal and lose all hope when they see the facts about Mormonism. Many have become atheists, for they say they cannot trust the Bible, and there is nothing else to believe in. This is the time when experienced Christian ministries to Mormons are sorely needed. **We are blessed to be here for them and we have seen many come to know the Lord and be saved. Thank you for praying with us for them as well as for us. We need it very much. This is very stressing and hard work, but we love to do it.**

Please continue to pray for Debbie and her husband, Tim, and their little 5-year old son, David. Debbie is not doing well, but **they are trusting that the Lord is in control**, even though the present situation does not look very good for what we all have been asking of the Lord.

Our other friends Dale, Max, Pat, Merridy and Dick have a long-term health problems need our prayers. Please pray also for Bruce, Tom, Heber and Dave for the Lord's direction and blessings. Please pray for Dennis' severe sinus problems. His doctor is recommending surgery. We are now waiting for results of his CT scan that was taken 2 days ago to determine the extent of the surgery.

Let's pray for all these in faith and that in all things we'd submit to the will of God. (1 John 5:14.)
