### **We wish you a blessed Christmas!**

A few years ago there was a survey done in Europe among children between six and twelve years old, asking: *Why do we celebrate Christmas?* Most of them did not have any idea that Christmas is related to the Christian faith in Jesus as the Savior and Redeemer of mankind. They only knew that it was the time when they could expect gifts from Santa Claus on condition of being good. As far as Christmas songs, they knew *"Santa Claus Is Coming to Town"* and *"I'm Dreaming of a White Christmas"*, but nothing about Jesus. America is not far behind in that trend. Christ has been left out of Christmas. It has become, year by year, harder to find even cards that have *"Merry Christmas"* written on them or any reference to Jesus' Birth – they just say *"Happy Holidays"*. We, older people ☺ may still remember what Christmas used to be, but by watching TV shows or commercials, our young viewers are hard pressed to learn that **Christmas is supposed to honor the birth of Jesus Christ**, the prophetic event, foretold during 1500 prior years in the Bible by God's prophets.

Most people today have no idea that *there are over 300 prophecies in the Old Testament concerning the first coming of Jesus* that have been proven to have been fulfilled. About 750 years before the birth of Jesus Christ, the Prophet Isaiah wrote, (Isa. 7:14): ***"Therefore the LORD Himself will give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel"***. Fulfillment of this is recorded in Matt. 1:23: ***"Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and bear a son, and they shall call His name Emmanuel, which is translated, 'God with us'."*** As it was during the time of Jesus' birth, so it is today - ***"...seeing they see not...hearing they hear not"***. That Jesus was born is the historical fact, but the reason for His birth is often ignored. Isaiah wrote (9:6), ***"For unto us the Child is born, unto us the Son is given."*** ***[He is given to us so that we through Him may become children of God*** (John 1:12)]. **SALVATION IS GOD'S GIFT, GIVEN TO ALL WHO WILL RECEIVE Him.** A great majority of people reject God and His Word today as they did then when He came ***"as the lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world"***. (John 1:29.) **Is Christ a living reality in your life?** If He is not, then His birth in Bethlehem has no significance to you either. However, your eternity depends on your answers to these

few questions: ***Is He in your life today? Do you know Him personally? Have you been born again, as Jesus said we must be?*** (John 3:7.) (See also Romans 10:9-10 and Eph. 2:8-10.)

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem, certain wise men from the East came to Jerusalem asking, ***“Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East, and have come to worship Him. When Herod the king had heard these things, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him.”*** (Matt. 2:2-3.) King Herod then gathered the chief priests and scribes together and demanded to know if this was indeed a prophecy of Messiah, and if it was, he demanded to know where Christ, the Messiah of Israel, was to be born. They told him, ***“In Bethlehem of Judea: for thus it is written by the prophet: but you Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are not the least among the rulers of Judah: for out of you shall come a Ruler who will shepherd My people Israel.”*** (Matt. 2:5-6.)

It is interesting that these chief priests and scribes knew what was written in Micah 5:2, but there is no report telling that they did anything about it. They did not go looking for their Messiah-King *as did the wise men from the East* who had made this long journey to come and see, and worship Him. *It does not do much good to know the scriptures, unless you believe them, act on them and apply them to your lives, or does it?* It is very much the same today. **Some may know what is said there in, but they are not looking to see what is happening in our day concerning even yet unfulfilled prophecies of God. The entirety of God’s Word is given for us in the Bible** so that we *could know* what lies ahead, *and not be found ashamed* by ignorance of what God has foretold that has happened already, and what will happen before the Second Coming. (2 Tim. 2:15; 3:16.) **There is a great need to bring these prophecies into view, for we are nearing the Second Coming of Christ that the Bible records, even in more detail than about His First Coming.** (Matt. 24:3.)

Prophecy is not a popular subject in our day, but surely it all will take place just as God has said it will. **He will come again**, and that might be very soon. Ignoring Him and His Word does not change the eternal fact spoken of in John 3:36, “He who believes in the Son has [even now] everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abides on him.” He paid for my sins and your sins when He died on the cross of Calvary. ***“He was buried, and He rose again on the third day according to the scriptures”,*** and ascended to heaven. ***“This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven.”*** (1 Cor. 15:1-4; Acts 1:11.) Even during our lifetime we have seen many prophecies come to pass that were foretold to happen before **the Second Coming.** (Dan. 9:24-27). Can we not see from the signs of our time that His coming is getting near? In May 14, 1948 Israel was born ***“at once, in a day”*** (Isa. 66:8) when they gathered as a nation from the four corners of the world to **her own land** after nearly 2000 years of exile. (Ezekiel 36:19-24; Isa. 11:11-12.) As also was foretold, during their exile they did not lose their national identity, and in spite of living among nations around the world for those 2000 years, when they came back they did as the scriptures had promised, *i.e. that when they will return they will speak pure Hebrew language* (Zeph. 3:9), which is the official language of Israel today. **Incredible!**

Because Israel is *God's land*, yet a very small country, **all the nations are against her**, and *they want to divide her land* (Joel 3:2), but people of Israel *have stood upon their feet and built an exceedingly great army in order to defend themselves.* (Ezek. 37:10.) It should be obvious to all who know the scriptures that the war against Israel **is a spiritual war** – for the Devil is against all that belongs to God, **be it His Land or His chosen people.** This war has been on going, and **it is taking place even now.**

***“Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about... will make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all people... and all the people of the earth are gathered together against it.”*** (Zech.12:2-3)

To discover where we are in God's time-table, we must keep our eyes on Israel.

God reveals through Israel what He is doing in the world, for all prophecies, one way or another, are connected to Israel or the people of Israel, even though most of the Israelites themselves are still in unbelief. (See Ez. 36-39.) In Luke 21:28, God said, ***“Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption Draws near.”***

We must thank Israel, God's chosen people, for **the Bible, the Written Word of God** for without it, we, the non-Jews (called Gentiles) would not even have a **Knowledge of the True God of Israel.**

**Our Bible was written and preserved for all nations by the Jews.**

**Our Creator, and our soon coming King, is a Jew, and we must be ready to welcome Him back.**

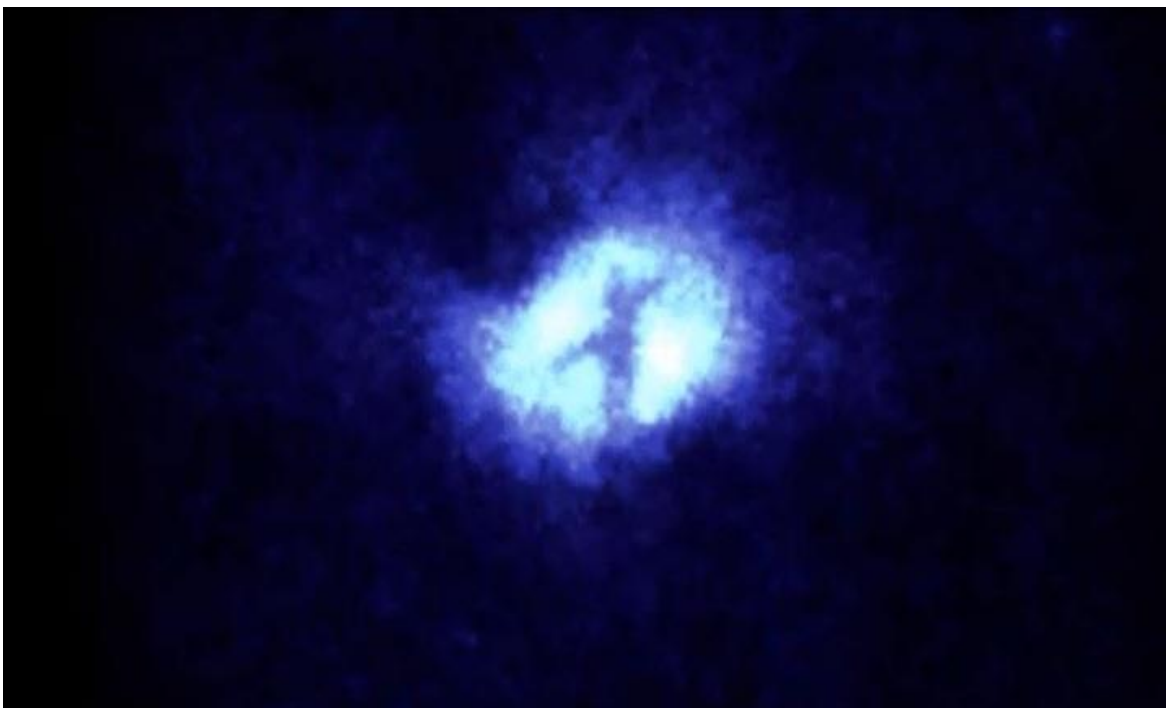
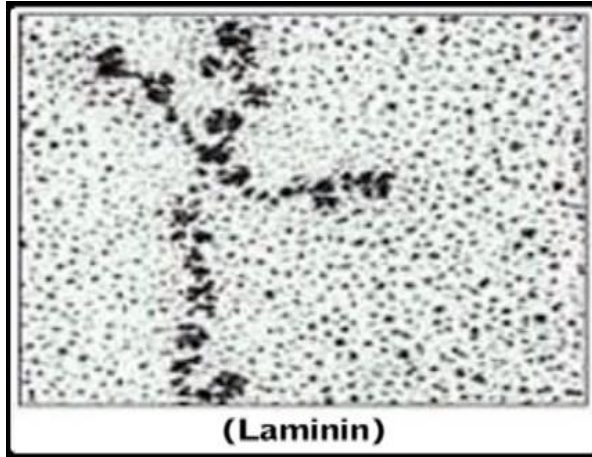
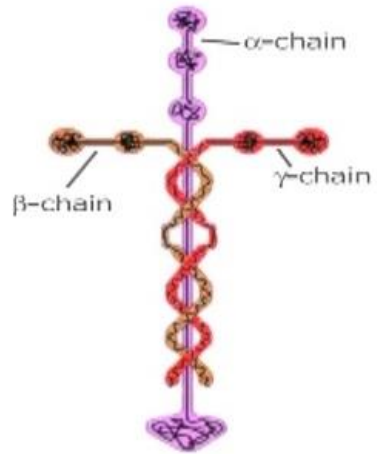
**“For by Him were all things created that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones or dominions, or principalities, or powers; all things were created by Him and for Him: and He is before all things and by Him all things consist.”** (Col. 1:16-17.)

The Apostle John wrote specifically of *this surety* in John 5:13, **“These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life.”** Thus we see that assurance actually comes from the Written Word of God. (See also John 1:1, 14; 6:28-29; 14:6; Eph. 2:8-9.) There is no need to just *hope or guess or rely on feelings*, **“for we are saved when we receive the Truth about Jesus who IS God, and rely on Him alone for our salvation and eternal life, which God, who cannot lie, has promised even before the world began.”** (Titus 1:2.)
